STEPS IN GIVING A DEMONSTRATION

1. Planning

- a. Choose an interesting subject on your 4-H project.
- b. List steps involved in the demonstration and outline them.
- c. Make a list of all of the materials and equipment needed.

2. Preparation

- a. Secure the necessary materials.
- b. Prepare demonstration according to plans.
- c. Practice.

3. Presentation

- a. Check to make sure you have everything you need.
- b. Speak slowly and clearly. SMILE!
- c. Keep your working area neat and clean.
- d. Ask for questions. Answer them as well as you can. If you don't have the answer, admit it.
- e. If you have a finished product, show it.
- f. Thank your audience for their attention.

GOOD DEMONSTRATIONS SHOULD HAVE THREE MAIN PARTS

1. Introduction

- a. Use a catchy title to get the attention of the audience.
- b. Tell briefly what you are showing.

2. Body

- a. Tell and show your project step by step.
- b. Talk while you are showing each step.
- c. Vísual aíds
- 3. Summary (Conclusion)
 - a. Briefly restate the MAIN points of your demonstration.

4. Demonstrations are 2-5 minutes in length.
