\_ 25 Jumbo Cornish Cross Chicken (\$100 per set)

\*All members and families MUST participate fully in meat bird auction <u>and processing day</u>. Cornish X will be sold in sets of sets of 25. Birds will come around the first week of August. This is an 8-week project based on rate of gain. Upon completion of the show and sale, birds will be processed and distributed. A minimum of 10 participants are required to proceed with the meat bird project. Failure to achieve the minimum will result in cancelation and a refund of deposit.

# 2025 4-H Poultry Program

This project requires that 4-H members have a place to raise and care for chickens. Have you ever wondered what it takes to raise chickens from being a day old to when it can lay an egg? Do you want to try raising some chickens on your own? How does starting your own egg selling business as young as a 4th grader sound? These are all things that 4-H'ers have been doing for DECADES with the 4-H poultry project.

#### Who can participate?

Any 4-12th grader enrolled in 4-H through public school, virtual/remote learners, or the home school program.

#### Why participate in the 4-H Chick Chain Program instead of purchasing birds on your own?

- ✓ Includes Pullets
- ✓ Includes supplies from Farm Co-op
- ✓ Includes an Introductory Class
- ✓ Builds a community of young farmers

- ✓ Learn about raising birds from those who show
- Understand Poultry Varieties: Egg Layers vs. Meat Birds
- ✓ Raises more money for future 4-H farmers

#### How does the Chick Chain Project Work?

- 1. If you want to participate in the chick chain, mail or deliver a copy of the 2025 application with your deposit.
- 2. A minimum of 20 4-H members must apply to have the 2025 Poultry Program. A maximum of 10 members will be selected to participate in the meat bird project.
- 3. You will be contacted whether or not your application is accepted on or after February 1, 2025.
- 4. First-time participants are required to participate in a poultry 101 class, to educate them on what it takes to raise a Grand Champion Pullet.
- 5. Members should plan to participate in the monthly Campbell County 4-H Poultry and Rabbit Club.
- 6. All 4-H'ers will receive chicks to raise, starting around the end of April 2025.
- 7. All 4-H'ers will bring **three** chickens per breed to the show and auction in the fall.
- 8. 4-H'ers will be expected to maintain a project record book. This record book will be turned in after the Chick Chain Show, for judging.
- 9. The Show and Auction will be held during National 4-H week (First week of October, 2025). The 4-H'er MUST BE PRESENT FOR THE ENTIRE SHOW. You will be required to RSVP.
- 10. For members participating in the meat bird project, members and at least 1 adult family member <u>must</u> be present on processing day. Meat birds sold at auction will remain in the position of the member until the processing date. The member will be responsible for delivery of processed birds to their buyer.
- 11. If your birds die, contact us ASAP for an alternative plan.
- 12. 4-H'ers will compete to receive the highest award for their breed of bird, Grand Champion.

#### When and how do I register?

While you are encouraged to turn it in early, you must turn in your deposit <u>NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1,</u> <u>2025.</u> MAIL OR RETURN THE APPLICATION AND DEPOSIT TO THE UT EXTENSION OFFICE.
